5-10-2021	<p>Taken up. Mr. Pranay Choubey, learned counsel for the appellant. Shri J.K.Pillai, learned counsel for the respondent. Perused the report of the Registry.</p> <p>The Impugned order is of 14-6-2018, the appeal has been filed on 19-2-2011, hence beyond limitation. The learned counsel for appellant refers to order of Hon'ble High court of Madhya Pradesh at Jabalpur. Copy on record passed in Writ Petition No.5638/2020 on 9-2-2021. Hence in the light of direction of Hon. High Court above noted, delay in filing the appeal is condoned.</p> <p>Learned Counsel for respondent has raised the point of 7-O of the EPFA Act. There is an application of appellant filed under Section 7-O of the Act that the mandatory deposit under Section 7-O be ddispensed with.</p>	

It has been opposed by learned counsel for the respondent. This application does not disclose any specific reason for dispensing with the deposit, though it has been mentioned in the oral submission of learned counsel for the appellant. The Appellant is directed to file an affidavit stating the conditions/grounds for dispensing with the mandatory deposit under Section 7-O within one week from today, after giving a copy to Respondent learned counsel who may file its counter and objection on application under Section 7-O of the Act within a week thereafter.

The matter be taken up for hearing on application under Section 7-O of the Act on 25-10-2021.
