The record is put up before me today on the basis of an application filed by Mr. Bibhas Banerjee, learned advocate for the appellant.

A separate verified application dated 06/10/2025 has been filed by the appellant stating therein that the instant appeal against order dated 28/03/2025 under section 14-B and 7-Q of EPF&MP Act, 1952 was admitted on 17/07/2025 and Notice was issued to the respondent. The respondent appeared before the Tribunal on 17/07/2025, 14/08/2025 and 18/09/2025. Respondent authority thereafter issued Notice bearing No./RO/WB/DGP/0041862/Recovery/CC-II/4237 dated 17/09/2025 and directed the appellant to liquidate the outstanding dues to the tune of Rs. 12,80,58,589 (twelve crore eighty lakh fifty eight thousand five hundred and eighty nine only) within seven days on receipt of the communication in respect of the RRC, failing which recovery action would be initiated in accordance with Section 8B to 8G of EPF&MP Act, 1952 without any further Notice. Appellant herein has prayed for issuing direction to the respondent authority to stay all further proceedings till disposal of the instant appeal on a plea that the appellant will suffer loss. Copy of application appears to have been served upon the office of EPFO, Durgapur on 06/10/2025.

Ld. Advocate for the appellant petitioner moved the application praying for stay of Impugned Order. Perused the record, Impugned Order and Notice issued to the appellant setting the recovery proceeding in motion. Let the petition dated 06/10/2025 be fixed on 06/11/2025 for hearing in presence of Id. Advocate for the respondent. In the meantime, respondent is directed not to take any coercive action against the appellant in respect of subject matter of this appeal. To date for hearing of application, objection in the meantime. Inform the respondent through their advocate.
