**ORDER**

Called out. Both sides are present. Heard the argument of the Learned Counsel for the appellant on the point of admission of the appeal.


The present appeal is filed by the appellant under Sec 7(I) of the EPF and MP Act 1952 challenging the impugned order No. KR/KCH/15663/Penal Damages/2022/163 dated 21.07.2022 and KR/KCH/15663/ Penal Interest/2022. There is delay in filing the

appeal. This appeal is filed on 01.11.2022. As per provision, an appeal may be filed within 60 days. Further 60 days time may be extended by this Tribunal. After extension of 60 day's time, the appeal is admissible and accordingly the appeal is admitted. The impugned order is stayed subject to the remittance of 20% of the determined amount of damages U/Sec 14B of the EPF and MP Act 1952 within four weeks from the date of order and proof of remittance be submitted to the Court. No coercive action shall be taken to recover the remaining amount until disposal of the appeal or further direction of the Tribunal.
