## ORDER

Present Appeal is filed from Order No.KR/KK/23946/ENF-4(4)/14B/2016/1671 dated 20.06.2016 assessing damages under Sec 14B of the EPF & MP Act 1952 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') for belated remittance of contribution for the period from 02/2015 to 03/2016.

2. The appellant filed WP(C) No.624/2017 before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala and the Hon'ble High Court vide judgement dated 29.03.2017 directed the appellant to approach the Tribunal within sixty days from the date of receipt of the

judgement. Present appeal is filed as per the direction of the

Hon'ble High Court.

3. Notice dated 15.12.2017 was issued to the parties

directing to appear on 05.01.2018. Thereafter the matter was

posted on various dates and finally on 05.12.2018 and

02.01.2019. There was no representation for the appellant.

Respondent was represented by the Standing Council and filed

counter.

4. The learned Counsel for the respondent submitted the

damages as per the impugned order is already recovered and the

appellant may not be interested in pursuing the appeal.

Hence the appeal is dismissed for default.
