The record has been put up today for appearance of the parties as directed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in WPC No.7963 of 2021. The Counsel for both the parties appeared and participated in the hearing held through Video Conferencing. On hearing the counsel for both the parties and on perusal of the order dated 06th August 2021 passed in the above writ petition it is found that the Hon'ble High Court have been pleased to restore the appeal of the petitioner dismissed on 06.04.2018 subject to compliance of the conditions mentioned in the order. The Hon'ble Court have directed the appellant to satisfy this tribunal that the entire interest amount of Rs. 25,97,260/- stand deposited. Though, no document to that effect has been filed the Ld. Counsel for the appellant submitted about deposit of the interest amount which was accepted by the Ld. Counsel for the respondent.

Further perusal of the order of the Hon'ble High Court reveals that the Ld. Counsel for the appellant submitted before the Hon'ble Court that Rs. 20,00,000/- out of the damage assessed has already been deposited. Considering the said submission the Hon'ble High Court passed the order restoring the appeal to its original No.

Today during course of hearing the Ld. Counsel for the respondent though accepted the contention of the appellant about deposit of the interest amount, requested for filing of some document evidencing deposit of Rs. 20,00,000/- out of the damage amount before the tribunal proceeds to hear the appeal on merit. In view of the same and in order to avoid confusion the appellant is directed to file an affidavit on 24.08.2018 indicating clearly the date and the amount deposited by it towards the damage (20,00,000/-) and entire interest. As an abundant caution the respondent is directed to produce the LCR for cross checking of the same. List this matter on 24.08.2021 through VC for further proceeding.
