Shri Abhishek Arjaria, Learned counsel for the Respondent.</p> <p>Perused the report of the Registry.</p> <p>The impugned order is of 20.01.2025. The appeal has been filed on 02.04.2025. The appeal is within extended period of limitation. Ground sufficient. Hence, delay is condoned. Appeal is registered.</p> <p>The learned counsel for appellant presses his I.A.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondent authority has opposed the application of waiver and prayed regarding recovery for stay orally.</p> <p>After hearing both the sides on the application for recovery of stay and objection against it and on perusal of the record. I am of the view that the appellant has successfully made out a prima facie case in his favor and it will be in the interest of justice to stay the recovery but on certain conditions.</p> <p>Accordingly the recovery of the amount under appeal passed under Section 14-B of the Act is stayed, subject to the condition of deposit of 40% of the amount with the Respondent within 30 days from the date of order and file a compliance report. I.A. is disposed of accordingly. Any amount deposited earlier shall be adjusted.</p> <p>Point of maintainability of appeal against under section 7Q. Appellant is at liberty to seek remedy against order under Section 7Q before proper forum.</p> <p>Respondent to file Counter within 04 weeks from today, after serving a copy to the learned counsel of the Appellant.
