Order dated 19.10.2022 passed by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court has been perused.

As per the said order of the Hon'ble High Court, the ad interim relief stands extended till the end of January, 2023, or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

Today, the learned Authorised Representative for the appellant has sought adjournment by filing an application alleging that the respondent may be directed to call for the lower Court records for the proceedings held under Sections 7A, 7Q and 14B. He submits that he wants to refer to the said record to buttress his arguments. To this, learned counsel for the respondent has no objection and he states at the bar that he shall ensure that the entire record of the proceedings comes before the next date of hearing.

The learned Authorised Representative for the appellant has also mentioned in the application filed today that he shall withdraw Writ Petition No. 6418 of 2022 which is pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay as the matter is being heard by this Tribunal.

The lower Court record be also summoned well before the date fixed.
