Shri J.K.Pillai, Learned counsel for the Respondent.</p> <p>Perused the report of the Registry.</p> <p>The impugned order is of 14.12.2023 The appeal has been filed on 23-02-2024, hence barred by limitation. The appellant has filed an application for condonation of delay, supported with an affidavit. The ground taken is sufficient, accordingly the delay is condoned. Insite of being vehemently opposed by the learned counsel for the respondent orally. Accordingly condoning the delay, the appeal is registered</p> <p>Respondents to counter within four weeks from today with documents after serving a copy thereof to learned counsel for the appellant. Rejoinder if any, within two weeks, thereafter.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the appellant further pressed his IA.</p> <p>The respondent has vehemently opposed this application.</p> <p>After hearing both the sides on the application for recovery of stay and objection against it and on perusal of the record.
