Heard on the application for condonation of delay filed by the appellant.

The impugned order is dated 04.01.2022 and the present appeal was filed on 06.04.2022.

The limitation to file an appeal is 60 days.

In view of the order dated 10.01.2022 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Misc. Application No.21 of 2022 in Misc. Application. No.665 of 2021 in Suo Moto Writ Petition (C) No.3 of 2020, the period from 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022 shall stand excluded for the purpose of limitation as may be prescribed under the general or special law in respect of all judicial or quasi-judicial proceedings. Over & above this, a limitation period of 90 days from 01.03.2022 has also been granted in cases where the limitation would have expired during the period between 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022.

In view of the above, the present appeal having been filed within 90 days from 01.03.2022, is within limitation. Thus, the said application accordingly stands allowed.

The appellant has filed an application today for stay of the impugned order.

On request of both sides, the case is adjourned to 31.03.2023 the date already fixed, for reply and arguments on the stay application and the application under Section 7O of the EPF & MP Act, 1952.

The lower court record be also summoned.
