Rejoinder on behalf of appellant filed.

Heard on the application for condonation of delay. The present application has been filed against the order dated 06.05.2025 passed under Section 7A of the Act. It is further stated that there was heavy rain and land slide in Kullu, Himachal Pradesh and most of the roads were closed and due to this reason, there was delay of 113 days in filing the appeal. In reply it is maintained that the applicant has stated that they could not gathered the information. However, it is admitted that there was heavy rain and land slide in Kullu. Keeping in view Rule 7A of the Tribunal (Procedural) Rules, 1997 which provides time for filing delay of 60 days and it is further extendable for another 60 days subject to sufficient cause and the fact that appeal was within 120 days. The appeal is in time, in view of the fact that there was heavy rain and land slide in the area. The application is allowed.

Registered is as a regular appeal.

Operation of the impugned order is stayed subject to deposit of 25% of the amount assessed under Section 7A within one month. The case is adjourned for 30.10.2026 for filing reply to the main appeal.
