

25/7/2022	<p>Taken up.</p> <p>Shri Kamal Khemuka, learned counsel for the appellant. Shri J.K.Pillai, learned counsel for the respondent.</p> <p>Heard on admission. Perused the report of the Registry.</p> <p>The impugned order is passed on 4-8-2020 and the appeal has been filed on 23-12-2021, barred by limitation. The appellant has filed an application for condonation of delay.</p> <p>I have heard both the sides on condonation of delay. IN the light of the directions of Hon'ble the Apex Court in Misc. Appeal No.665/2021 in SMW(C) No.3/2020, the delay may be condoned inspite of objections by learned counsel for the Respondent and the delay is condoned accordingly.</p> <p>The learned counsel for the appellant has further pressed application for seeking exemption from pre depositing the amount under appeal under Section 7(o) of the Act.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondent has vehemently opposed the application.</p> <p>I have heard both the learned counsel on an application under Section 7(o) of the Act. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the appellant that the amount has already been recovered from the appellant, rather the Respondent Authority has recovered more than the amount under Appeal. This fact is corroborated from the record, hence inspite of opposition by learned counsel for Respondent, complete waiver under Section 7(o) of the Act is granted.</p> <p>Appeal be admitted for hearing.</p> <p>Respondent to counter within four weeks from today with documents after serving a copy thereof to learned counsel for the appellant.
