The present appeal under Section 7-I of the Employees' Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952, [herein after referred to as 'the Act'] is directed against the order dated 28.01.2025 passed by the respondent under Section 7-A of the Act.

Heard on the application for waiver on depositing 75% of assessed amount filed by the appellant along with the appeal.

CGIT-2/ EPFA/37 OF 2025

As per the impugned order, the amount of penalty under Section 7-A of the Act is Rs.27,55,146/-.

After hearing both the sides and going through the case file carefully, it is ordered that the appellant shall deposit 75% of the amount of Rs.27,55,146/- as assessed under Section 7-A of the Act with the respondent within four weeks from today till then no coercive action may be taken against the appellant with regard to recovery of the award amount.

It is made clear that in case, the said 75% amount is not deposited within the stipulated time, the stay order shall stand vacated automatically. List this case on already fixed date for further proceedings of the case.
