Called out. Both sides are present. Heard the argument of the Learned Counsel for the appellant on the point of admission of the appeal.


The present appeal is filed by the appellant under Sec 7(I) of the EPF and MP Act, 1952 challenging the impugned order dated 08.05.2025 (Diary No.92/2023). This appeal was filed on 29.07.2025. There is delay in filing the appeal. However, as per the direction in judgment dated 15.07.2025 of the Hon'ble High Court of

Kerala in WP(C) No.25499/2025, granted 15 days time for the appellant to file the appeal before this Tribunal and the appeal was filed on 29.07.2025. This Tribunal heard both sides and accordingly the appeal is admitted. The impugned order is stayed subject to the remittance of 25% of the determined amount of damages U/Sec 7A of the EPF and MP Act, 1952 within four weeks from the date of order and proof of remittance be submitted to the Court. If any amount deposited by the appellant/recovered by the respondent may be adjusted. No coercive action shall be taken to recover the remaining amount until disposal of the appeal or further direction of the Tribunal.
