This appeal was initially filed by the Appellant in EPF Appellant Tribunal, New Delhi against Order No. KR/KC/24523/Enf III (6)/2012/3535 dated 12.06.2012 of the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, Kochi by which damages amounting to Rs. 21,77,214/- was levied against appellant under Section 7A of the Act.

2. This Appeal was dismissed from Employees Provident Fund Tribunal, New Delhi on 08.04.2014 by the order of Presiding Officer, EPF Appellate Tribunal, New Delhi. This case file was later transferred to this Tribunal.
3. This appeal was re-opened as a fresh case by the Central Government Industrial Tribunal cum Labour Court as per the judgement dated 23.01.2025 of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP(C) No. 6407 of 2018.
4. Notice for appearance were issued to both parties. Notice of appellant unclaimed. Appeal was posted during Special Campaign and called on 09.03.2026. Notice for Special Campaign was again unclaimed by the appellant and was also not present during Special Campaign on 09.03.2026. This case coming up for hearing on 20.04.2026 and the same day this Industrial Tribunal – cum – Labour Court passed the following:
