By this application the appellant/ applicant is seeking condonation of delay in filing an appeal. Perused the exhaustive reply given by the respondent/ opponent. Heard both the sides.

According to the applicant, he received the order dated 13.12.2019 on 28.02.2020 and the present appeal is filed on 12.03.2020. Though this fact has been denied by the opponent, in my opinion if the date or receipt of order is considered then, the present appeal is within the prescribed period of limitation i.e., 60 days and even otherwise if the date of order is i.e., 13.12.2019 is considered then also the present appeal is within the period of 120 days from the date of passing of order therefore the applicant is certainly entitled for condonation of delay in filing an appeal.
