10.01.2025	<p>Matter taken up.</p> <p>Shri Praveen Yadav, Learned counsel for the Appellant Shri Abhishek Arjaria, Learned counsel for the Respondent.</p> <p>Perused the report of the Registry.</p> <p>The impugned order is of 30.09.2024. The appeal has been filed on 19.12.2024. The appeal is within extended period of limitation. Ground sufficient. Hence, delay is condoned. Appeal is registered.</p> <p>The learned counsel for Appellant presses his I.A.</p> <p>Learned Counsel for the Respondent, Shri Abhishek Arjaria, who has been served copies of the appeal and IA, undertakes to file Vakalatnama for the Respondent and orally opposes these Applications.</p> <p>After hearing both the sides on the application for recovery of stay and objection against it and on perusal of the record. I am of the view that the Appellant has successfully made out a prima facie case in his favor and it will be in the interest of justice to stay the recovery but on certain conditions.</p> <p>Accordingly the recovery of the amount under appeal passed under Section 14-B of the Act is stayed, subject to the condition of deposit of 40% of the amount with the Respondent within 30 days from the date of order and file a compliance report. I.A. is disposed of accordingly. Any amount deposited earlier shall be adjusted. Point of maintainability of appeal against under section 7Q. Appellant is at liberty to seek remedy against order under Section 7Q before proper forum.</p> <p>Respondent to file Counter within 04 weeks from today, after serving a copy to the learned counsel of the Appellant.
