This case coming up for admission on 31.03.2022 and the same day this Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court passed the following:

ORDER

Both sides are represented. The impugned order is issued U/s 7A of the Act assessing dues. According to the learned Counsel for the appellant, the

appellant establishment is not coverable as all the employees were drawing

salary above statutory limit. It was also argued that there was no notice to the

appellant after the 1st two postings.

The impugned order is dt.26.10.2018. However the learned Counsel for

the appellant submitted that Sec 7B review application is disposed only on

12.04.2021.

Taking into account the pleadings of the learned Counsel for the

appellant, the appeal is admitted and the impugned order is stayed, on the

condition that the appellant shall remit 25% of the assessed dues with the

respondent within a period of one month from today. The respondent is

restrained from taking any coercive action for the recovery of the dues. The

appellant shall produce proof of remittance before the next date of posting.

The respondent filed counter. Adjourned to 27.07.2022 for hearing.
