Heard both side.</p> <p>Perused the report of the Registry.</p> <p>The impugned order is of 16.04.2024. The appeal has been filed on 14.06.2024, hence within limitation. The appeal is registered.</p> <p>The learned counsel for appellant presses his IA and application U/S 7(o).</p> <p>Heard application under section 7(O) and IA. Perused record.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondent authority has opposed the application of waiver and prayer regarding stay of recovery.</p> <p>After perusal of record in the light of rival arguments, the Appellant appears to have successfully established some arguable points in the appeal, hence he has successfully established his prima facie case at this stage, keeping in view the fact and circumstances of the case in hand, the balance of convenience is in favor of granting partial waiver under Section 7(O). Accordingly the amount under Section 7(O) is partially waived and the appellant is directed to deposit only 40% of the amount under appeal in favor of <b>Registrar CGIT (Payable at Jabalpur)</b> within 30 days from today.</p> <p>Respondent to file Counter within 04 weeks from today, after serving a copy to the learned counsel of the Appellant.
