**ORDER**

Present appeal is filed from order No. KR / KNR / 10043 /  
Enf-1(5) / Damages / 2011 / 6869 dt.21/01/2013 assessing

damages U/s 14B of EPF & MP Act, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act'.) for belated remittance of contribution for the period from 06/2004 to 02/2010. The total damages assessed is Rs. 3,73,985/-. The interest demanded U/s 7Q of the Act for the same period is also being challenged in this appellant.

2. The present appeal is filed on the ground that the appellant was not provided adequate opportunity before the impugned orders were issued. When the matter was taken up for final hearing the learned Counsel for the respondent submitted that the appellant has already remitted the damages as claimed in the impugned order. The appellant remitted the interest also. At any cost no appeal is maintainable from an order issued U/s 7Q of the Act.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to interfere with the impugned orders.

Hence the appeal is dismissed.
