This case coming up for admission on 29.04.2021 and the same day this Tribunal-cum-Labour Court passed the following:

ORDER

Both sides are represented. According to the Counsel for the appellant, the impugned order is issued U/s 7A of the Act assessing dues in respect of a single employee. According to the Counsel for the respondent, the assessment is made on the basis of an experience certificate issued by the appellant.

It is pointed out by the learned Counsel for the appellant that the experience certificate was issued to facilitate the better employment. The appellant failed to make out a prima facie case in his favour and therefore the appellant will have to remit atleast his share of contribution U/s 7(O) of the Act as a precondition for admitting the appeal.

The appeal is admitted subject to remittance of 50% of the assessed dues within a period of 4 weeks from today with the respondent. Proof of remittance shall be produced on or before the next date of posting. Subject to above the impugned order is stayed until further orders.
