This case coming up for admission on 29.06.2022 and the same

day this Tribunal-cum-Labour Court passed the following:

<u>O R D E R</u>

Both sides are represented.

The impugned order is issued under Sec 7A of the EPF and MP

Act on non-enrolled employees, evaded wages and short remittance.

The learned Counsel for the appellant admitted that the liability under short remittance is admitted, and he is disputing the liability under non-enrolled employees and evaded wages.

There is delay in filing the appeal. The delay is condoned in view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

The learned Counsel for the appellant submitted that the predeposit under Sec 7(O) of the Act may be confined to the admitted liability. The learned Counsel for the respondent opposed the prayer.

The appeal is admitted subjected to remittance of 40% of the assessed dues with the respondent within a period of one month from today. Subject to the above, the impugned order is stayed and the respondent is restrained from taking any coercive action for recovery.

Respondent filed counter. Adjourned to 01.09.2022 for confirmation and hearing
