Tribunal-cum-Labour Court passed the following:

**ORDER**

Both sides are represented. The impugned order is issued by the respondent U/s 7A of EPF & MP Act,1952. The learned Counsel for the appellant submitted that they moved the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala against the Bank attachment by the respondent U/s 8F and the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.(C) no.8490/2022 directed the respondent to lift the attachment subject to payment

of Rs.5 Lakhs. The Counsel also submitted the Bank transferred the amount to the respondent and Bank attachment is lifted.

It is seen that impugned order is issued assessing the regular dues. The learned Counsel for the appellant submitted that the appellant is a sick company and on the verge of closure. Taking into account the financial position pleaded by the appellant the appeal is admitted and the impugned order is stayed until further orders and the respondent is restrained from taking further action subject to remittance of 40% of the assessed dues with the respondent within a period of two months including the remittance made by the appellant as per the direction of Hon'ble High Court. Subject to above, the appeal is admitted.
