This case coming up for hearing on 18.02.2021 and the same day this Tribunal-cum-Labour Court passed the following:

## ORDER

It is seen that the appeal is filed from four different orders issued U/s 14B and Sec 7(Q) of EPF & MP Act. The appeal was taken up for admission on 11.03.2020 and the Counsel appearing for the appellant was informed that a single appeal cannot be filed from four different orders, which is in violation of Rule 10 of EPF Appellate Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1997. The appellant sought time to cure the defect. Today, when the matter is again taken up, there is no

representation for the appellant. The Counsel for the respondent submitted that the appellant has not taken any action for curing the defect pointed out during the last posting.

Hence the appeal is dismissed being defective.
