The four applicants present with their Ld. Counsel. Shri Praveen Yadav Adv. for management also present he informs that Ld. Adv. Shri Vijay Tripathi is conducting this case.

I have gone through the record; according to the applicants they are entitled to wages Rs. 5494/- per month as last drawn under order of Hon'ble High Court of M.P. U/s 17(B) of the I.D.
