AWARD

The appropriate government had sent the reference to this tribunal for adjudication with the following words.

“Whether Ms. Monidipa Sen, who has worked from 26-10-2015 to 24-01-2019 as Manager-Logistics with the management of CSC e-Governance Services India Ltd, can be called as ‘workman’ within the definition of ‘workman’ under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947,? If yes, then whether her services with the management of CSC e-Governance Services India Ltd were terminated in an illegal and unjustified manner by forcing her

to submit resignation? If yes, then what relief(s) she is entitled to?”

After receiving the said reference, notices were issued to both the parties. Both the managements have not been appearing on the date, and not filed the WS. However, the claimant is appearing, but, after giving last opportunity for filing claim statement, he has not come forward to file his claim statement before this tribunal.

In these circumstances, this tribunal has no option except to pass the no disputant award. Hence, no disputant award is passed accordingly. File is consigned to the record room. A copy of this award is hereby send to the appropriate government for notification under section 17 of the I.D. Act 1947.
