**A W A R D**

This is an application filed u/s 2A of the Id. Act by the claimant wherein he has alleged illegal termination with a prayer for reinstatement in service with full back wages and consequential benefits. Notice being served, the mgt appeared through it's A/R and on completion of pleadings issues were framed by order dated 01.08.2022. When the matter was pending for evidence to be adduced by the claimant, a proposal was advanced by the parties for amicable settlement. The matter was adjourned to 11.02.2023 for settlement during the National Lok Adalat. Prior to that date on 24.01.2023 the claimant gave a statement to the effect that he has settled the dispute with the mgt and does not have any grievance against the mgt for which he wants to withdraw the proceeding. In view of the said statement the matter was decided during the National Lok Adalat held on 11.02.2023 and this no dispute award has been passed.

Hence ordered.

**Order**

The claim petition is dismissed for want of dispute raised by the claimant and this award is accordingly passed.
