L No. 189/2024 on 02.04.2025 observing that if the petitioner i.e. the Appellant Establishment preferred an appeal within 30 days from date of receipt of copy of the order, neither the Respondent nor the Tribunal shall take plea of limitation and shall decide the appeal in accordance with law. This period ended on 02.05.2025. Learned Counsel for Appellant Establishment referred to another order of Hon’ble High Court of Chhattisgarh at Bilaspur in MCC No. 634/2025 passed on 03.07.2025 in which the said period has been extended till 15 days from the date of the order in the MCC.
