

05-02-2026 The Appeal is fixed up today in the special campaign for appearance of parties and hearing of Appeal. As per last order dated 18-12-2025, fresh notices were issued to the parties through Speed post informing them that the Appeal is fixed up today i.e. 05-02-2026 and as per the postal track consignment, notices were delivered to the parties on 30-12-2025 but today also the Appellant and the Respondent were remained absent till 2.45 p.m.

Record reveals that the Appeal was filed by the appellant on 16-07-2019 praying for setting aside the impugned order dated 04-05-2016 passed by the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner-II, Guwahati directing the appellant to deposit the pending panel damages and interest amount of Rs. 11,123.00 and Rs. 10,958.00 respectively to the statutory accounts.

On perusal of the case record, it appears that the Appellant remains absent since 24-04-2020. Though the Respondent appeared through their engaged learned Advocate Mr. Hareesh Gupta on 23-07-2025 but thereafter the Respondent side also remains absent without any steps. It appears to me that the Appellant is not inclined to proceed with the Appeal for which he has not taken any steps since long.

Hence, the Appeal is dismissed for default. Let copy of the Order be communicated to the parties under Rule 20 of the Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1997.
