ORDER

The matter came up today being advanced for hearing of the application filed under section 7-L(2) of the EPF & MP.Act filed by the appellant praying review of the order dated 2.11.2016. Copy of the application was served on the respondent but none appeared today to move or oppose the said application.

Perusal of the application shows that an order was passed by this Tribunal on 2.11.2016 dismissing the appeal as not maintainable. The said order was passed on 2.11.2016 and the present application was filed on 15.12.2016 praying review. Since then, the application is getting adjourned for consideration. Though none moved the application today, on perusal of the record it is observed that the appellant has prayed for a review of the order on merit

which is not permissible under the provisions of section 7-L(2) of the EPF & MP Act which only aims at correcting the errors apparent on the face of the record. The petition is held devoid of merit and rejected.
