ORDER

- 1. The present appeal is filed by the appellant under section 7(I) of the EPF & MP Act, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as 'Act') against the order dated 10.01.2020 passed by the Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner, the Respondent under section 7 A of the Act.
- 2. The appellant has filed condonation of delay application.
- 3. At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the respondent Mr. Suresh Kumar has not opposed the condonation of delay application. Perusal of the application for condonation of delay reveals that sufficient cause has been mentioned in the application. According to the verdict of Hon'ble Apex Court, due to the special

circumstances of the pandemic COVID-19, delay condonation application is allowed.
