30.12.2024	<p>Matter taken up.</p> <p>Learned Senior Advocate Shri Hemant Shrivastava present for Appellant Establishment with Shri Arun Patel Learned Counsel.</p> <p>Perused report of Registry. Order under appeal was passed on 03.12.2024, appeal filed on 27.12.2024 which is within limitation. No appeal is entertenable before this Tribunal against order u/s. 7-Q of the Act. Hence, this appeal is admitted to the extent of order u/s. 14-B of the Act only. The Appellant is at liberty to seek remedy against order u/s. 7-Q before appropriate Forum.</p> <p>Learned Senior Counsel pressed the I.A.. It has been submitted that the order was passed on 03.12.2024 after composite notice and inquiry, served on the Appellant Establishment only on 10.12.2024 and the Respondents have started execution of the order without waiting the lapse of limitation for filing appeal. He has referred to notice u/s. 8-F of the Act issued by the Respondent Authority on 19.12.2024 to the Bank directly without serving any show cause notice required under the Act to the Appellant Establishment for execution of the order. He has referred to letter of Bank issued to the Appellant Establishment issued on 20.12.2024, in the light of the aforesaid notice dated 19.12.2024 issued by Respondent Authority to the Bank. Learned Senior Counsel submits that this is a fit case for interim protection.</p> <p>Copy of petition and I.A. have already been served on Respondent Learned Counsel, but none is present for them. Advocate Shri Akash Choudhary, who has not filed any</p>
