The matter was taken for evidence of the workmen in the camp court held at Rishikesh. Before recording of the evidence Mr. Pant the Ld. A/R for the claimants submitted that the reference was received in respect of 27 contractual workers who were demanding regularization of service. At present, only 19 workmen are pursuing the matter. He submitted the list of the 19 workmen pursuing the matter serving copy of the mgt and the same is taken on record. Mr. Pant advanced a proposal that the candidature of these workmen may be considered by the mgt for regularization of the service by mutual discussion. After a preliminary round of discussions and being appraised that for some other workmen standing in the similar footing the mgt of AIIMS has constituted a committee to examine the possibility of their regularization the Ld. A/R Mr. Bhardwaj and the Ld. Law officer Mr. Pandy assured that they will carry forward the proposal to the mgt for consideration. Hence, the claimants appeal witness was not taken and the matter is adjourned to 22.05.2023 for the mgt to apprise about the progress on the proposed conciliation as a mode of Alternate Dispute Resolution.
