Mr. Neeraj Kewat Learned Counsel present for Judgment Debtor management, files application with photocopy of order sheet of Hon'ble High Court of Chhattisgarh at Bilaspur in W.P. 02/2026, which has been filed by the management against the Award and has prayed that the hearing of this Execution Petition be kept in abeyance till disposal of the said writ or disposal of interim applications, filed in the said writ. Heard both the sides on this application. Perused record. It comes out that a writ petition has been filed by management against the Judgment and Award, which is being sought to be executed, but there is nothing on record to show that the Award has been stayed by Hon'ble High Court. Hence, the proceedings of this execution case cannot be stayed only on the ground that a writ petition has been filed against he said Award, sought to be executed or some interim application has been filed in the said writ petition. The Judgment Debtor is directed to accomplish the Award or show cause as to why the Award not be executed by way of attachment and sale of movable/immovable properties of Judgment Debtor.
