25.06.2026	<p>Matter taken up.</p> <p>Mr. R.C. Shrivastava Learned Counsel present with Award Holder Devaram Rajwade. Mr. Neeraj Kewat Learned Counsel present for Judgment Debtor/ management, files photocopy document dated 24.06.2026 (paper no. M-___), which is communication by staff officer to Learned Counsel for management, which shows that Rs. 29500.69/-, 33601.58/- , 27938.17/- have been transferred u/s. 56 of Industrial Relations Code 2020 in the light of order dated 16.06.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Chhattisgarh in the W.P.A. No. 02/2026 in the saving bank accounts of the Award Holders Devaram Rajwade, Rajkumar and Rajdhani Rajwade, respectively. Learned Counsel for Award Holders submits that this is not the full wages which were last drawn by these Award Holders at the time their services were terminated. Hence, this is not full compliance of the said order. He has referred to judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of <i>Dena Bank Vs. Keerti Kumar Patel, reported in (1999) 2 SCC 106 para 20</i>. He further submits that the last drawn wages should have been paid from the date of Award and not from the date of order of Hon'ble High Court. He has further referred to another judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of <i>Dena Bank Vs. Ghanshyam, reported in (2001) 5 SCC 169 para 11 & 12</i>.
