Mr. Rajneesh Sharma learned Counsel present for Workman side. Mr. Shreyas Pandit learned Counsel present for management.

Workman union files application stating that certain demands claimed by them are not in accordance with the schedule under the Act. They have filed a Writ Petition No. 15585/2024 before Hon'ble High Court in this respect, which is pending. Further stated that since some of the demands do not come under the schedule under Minimum Wages Act, they are praying withdrawal of their claim. Application is accompanied with affidavit of President of the Union.

Management side has no objection, except for cost of litigation.

On perusal also, the reference which contains charter of demands, these demands do not qualify to be an Industrial Disputes as defined under the Act. Hence, the reference has become in fructuous in the light of said withdrawal application and stands disposed accordingly.
