Marko (GM Marketing) & Mr. Ajit Kumar Sharma (Senior Accounts Officer). Documents not admitted by management. Learned Counsel for management files one document letter dated 15.10.2024, copy served on union representative who not admits the documents. Learned Counsel for management of IOCL submits that Shri Sharma who claims to be the General Secretary of the Union is in fact not the General Secretary at present. Manish Kumar Choubey is the present General Secretary of the union and challenges the authority of Shri Sharma to appear in this case on behalf of the union. Shri Sharma submits that at present he is the General Secretary of the union and refers to photocopy document letter of Registrar of Trade Union dated 29.09.2025 and Form-E attached. He submits that he has been recognized as General Secretary	

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	of the union at present. Parties are required to file affidavits stating their claims and counters on these points, after serving a copy. Leading the point of representation for the union open, cross examination of the management witnesses concluded by Shri Sharma for the union. List on 26.11.2025 for filing affidavits as stated above and hearing on the point as to which of the demand referred in the charter to the reference qualify to be Industrial Dispute under the Act.
