Heard arguments from both the sides.

Learned Counsel for management Bank submits that vide an order, they were directed to file original inquiry papers which they could not file because the original inquiry papers including documents and report of handwriting expert were handed over to the Investigating Officer during the investigation of a case arising out of First Information Report registered by Bank in this respect and are in the Court file.

Learned Counsel for workman submits that these cases had been concluded much before and the workman has been acquitted of the same charges.

The photocopy inquiry papers were not accepted earlier because this fact was not disclosed by management. If management wants to file authenticated photocopy of the inquiry documents, they are at liberty to file it after serving a copy to the workman side and also with affidavit of someone authorized by Bank in this behalf to state that the original documents are in the Court file.

Parties are at liberty to file written arguments also within two weeks after serving copy to their opposite party.
