Learned Senior Counsel Shri Anoop Nair present for management, assisted by Learned Counsel Shri Neeraj Kewat. Learned Counsel Shri Subodh Agrawal present for workman.

Heard arguments of both the sides. It came out during the arguments that the workman was appointed as land oustee, workman Learned Counsel has referred to I.I. 29 Read with NCWA-IV in support of his argument that, the workman was entitled to be given appointment as a land oustee on the post of clerk because he was entitled and was qualified for it, as per rules mentioned above, being a matriculate. Hence, it becomes necessary to ascertain whether there was any vacancy of a clerk when the appointment of the workman was considered by management and whether the workman was considered for the post of clerk by management if vacancy was there. Also, if the workman was considered for appointment on the post of clerk by management, on what grounds he was not appointed as a clerk. Management is directed to file as supplementary affidavit of someone authorized by management on these points, till or before next date.
