Shri Abhishek Arjaria, Learned Counsel for the Respondent.</p> <p>Perused the report of the Registry.</p> <p>The order under appeal has been passed under Section 7A of the Employees Provident Fund And Misc. Provisions Act.1952, herein after referred to the word "Act", passed on 26.05.2022. The appeal has been filed on 04.02.2025, hence barred by limitation.</p> <p>Application has been opposed by the respondent. Rule 7(2) of EPFA tribunal procedure rule 1997 is as follows.</p> <p>"Any person aggrieved by a notification issued by the Central Government or an order passed by the Central Government or any other authority under the Act, may within 60 days from the date of issue of the notification/order prefer an appeal to the Tribunal:</p> <p>Provided that the Tribunal may, if it is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient cause from preferring the appeal within the prescribed period, extend the said period by a further period of 60 days:</p> <p>.....</p> <p>Since, There are special provisions in the Act on limitation provision of limitation Act 1961 will not apply in case in hand.</p> <p>Accordingly, The application for condonation of delay deserve to be rejected and is rejected.</p> <p>Holding the appeal barred by limitation it is disposed as such.</p>
