**AWARD**

1. This is reference made by the Central Government in exercise of powers under clause (d) of sub-section (1) and sub-section (2A) of Section 10 of the

Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 vide Government of India, Ministry of Labour & Employment, New Delhi vide its order No. L-40011/12/2004 – IR (DU) dated 09.12.2004. The terms of reference given in the schedule are as follows :

*“Whether the action of the management of Telecom Factory, B.S.N.L., Deonar, Mumbai to discontinue the subsidized bus transport facility w.e.f. 01.05.2004 vide notice dated 31.03.2004 issued u/s 9-A of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 is legal, proper and justified ? If not, to what relief the concerned workmen are entitled and from which date and what other directions are necessary in the matter ?”*

2. After the receipt of the reference, both the parties were served with the notices.
3. In view of pursis [Ex.38], the second party union has withdrawn the reference.
4. As such the reference is withdrawn and hence disposed of. Hence order.
