Roznama reveals that the case is fixed for hearing on interim relief application filed by the Union. Representatives of 1st party no. 7 (M/s. Axis Bank Ltd.) and 1st party no. 8 (M/s. Sanjay Maintenance Services Pvt Ltd.) stated that written submission from 2nd party union was filed last night (17/05/2021) and could not be seen until today's morning. They want to file rejoinder against the written submission filed by the 2nd party Union. Short adjournment has been sought by both of them. Whereas, representative of the 2nd party Union stated that on previous hearing last opportunity was already afforded for the hearing and the matter being very urgent should be heard today.

On the insistence of representative of 2nd party Union, the matter is taken up for hearing on interim relief application. Further, representative of 2nd party Union stated that he will lead arguments on his own as his advocate is not present.

Heard representative of 2nd party Union followed by 1st party no. 7 at length for one and half hours. During hearing, at about 13:35 hrs, email from the learned counsel Mr. R.D Bhatt was communicated to the Presiding Officer stating that due to technical glitch he is not in a position to join the video conferencing. The tribunal directed the representative of 2nd party union to make phone call in the live video conferencing to Mr. R.D Bhatt and ask him to join the proceeding. Thereafter, the learned counsel for the 2nd party union Mr. R.D. Bhatt participated in the hearing and tribunal afforded him the opportunity to place his arguments.

In this way the hearing on interim relief application is finally concluded.

Order reserved.

It is hereby directed to both the parties that salary slips of the terminated employees be filed within a week and if 1st party No.7 wants to file rejoinder against the written submission filed by the 2nd party union the same may be filed within a week.
