- The present appeal is filed by the appellant U/s. 7-I of the EPF & MP Act 1952 (herein after referred to as Act) against the order passed u/s 7-A of the Act dated 11/11/2020 and pertains to the applicability of the Act only.
- 2. Along with appeal memo, Misc. Application for condonation of delay is also filed. The copy of the Appeal Memo and applications has been furnished to the Respondent.
- 3. It is stated by the learned counsel for the Appellant that Appellant is an Educational Institute School and due to spread of COVID-19 and lock down, the trustees of the appellant's school could not attend the office. The delay in filling the appeal was not

intentional or with any ill motive but was due to genuine problem faced by the appellant and the exigencies existing at that particular time. The appellant further

submitted that as per the verdict of the Hon'ble Apex Court " The period from

15/03/2020 to till 14/03/2021 shall also stand excluded in computing the periods

prescribed under section 23(4) and 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996,

Section 12A of the Commercial Court Act 1996 and provisos (b) and (C) of Section 138

of the Negotiable Instruments Act 1881 and any other laws, which prescribed

period(s) of limitation in instituting proceedings, outer limits (within which the court

or tribunal can condone delay) and termination of proceeding."

4. This condonation of delay application although vehemently opposed by the learned

counsel for the respondent. However, considering the pandemic circumstances and

the directions issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court and the grounds shown in the delay

application at para 4 found to be genuine and bonafide and also in view of verdict of

the Hon'ble Apex Court, I hereby allow the application for condonation of delay and

direct the office to register the case.

5. Miscellaneous application EPFA-33(c) is finally disposed of accordingly.
