Learned Counsel for the Respondent, Shri Abhishek Arjaria, who has been served copies of Copy of Memo of appeal and IA undertakes to file Vakalatnama</p> <p>Perused the report of the Registry.</p> <p>The impugned order is of 24.11.2025. The appeal has been filed on 23.01.2026. The appeal is within limitation. Hence, Appeal is registered.</p> <p>The learned counsel for appellant presses his I.A.</p> <p>After hearing Appellant side on the application for recovery of stay and on perusal of the record I am of the view that the appellant has successfully made out a prima facie case in his favor and it will be in the interest of justice to stay the recovery but on certain conditions.</p> <p>Accordingly the recovery of the amount under appeal passed under Section 14-B of the Act is stayed, subject to the condition of deposit of 40% of the amount with the Respondent within 30 days from the date of order and file a compliance report. I.A. is disposed of accordingly. Any amount deposited earlier shall be adjusted.</p> <p>Point of maintainability of appeal against under section 7Q.
