ORDER DATED 01.10.2021

Hearing conducted through video conferencing

The appeal came up for hearing on the directions dated 25.08.2021 of Hon'ble Delhi Court in W.P.(C) 8485/2021. As per the directions of the Hon'ble Delhi High court, this Tribunal has to consider the appeal qua the order passed u/s 7 Q of the Act. Accordingly, list the matter on 09.11.2021 for consideration of granting stay on the execution of order passed u/s 7 Q of the Act. Meanwhile, there shall be a stay on recovery of the amount as mentioned in the order passed u/s 7 Q of the Act.

Further, the ld. counsel for the Appellant pressed the application filed u/r 21 of the tribunal Rules seeking modification and directions to effect compliance of the order dated 03.08.2021. It was submitted on behalf of the Appellant that a partial compliance of the order dated 03.08.2021 has been done and prayed that the other respondents (i.e. resp. No. 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8) be directed to do the remaining compliance. The submission was strongly opposed by the Ld. Counsel for the Respondent no. 1 & 2. After careful consideration of the arguments, this tribunal is of the view that the period for making the full compliance be extended till 09.11.2021, which is the next date of hearing. Interim protection granted earlier against the recovery of the amount as mentioned in the order passed u/s 14B to continue till then.
